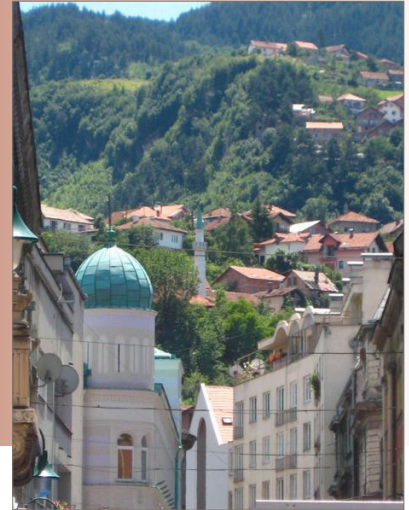


# Conflict Transformation Summer Program

## Combining Comparative Conflict Analysis and Travel

Abraham's Vision is now accepting applications for the 2009-10 Vision Program from Jewish and Palestinian university students, from the US and abroad, to participate in an experiential educational trip throughout the former Yugoslavia.



The Vision Program is an exceptional educational program in which members of both the Jewish and Palestinian communities living and/or studying in the United States travel together in Serbia, Kosovo, and Bosnia-Herzegovina to engage in a transformative process combining a rigorous academic focus of comparative conflict analysis and inter-group work. Students will learn about the conflicts in the former Yugoslavia, engage in comparative conflict workshops relating to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, and participate in group-dynamics sessions that both foster individual and group identities.

1. **JOINT PROGRAMMING MODEL:** involving an equal participation of Jewish and Palestinian students and staff.
2. **COMPARATIVE APPROACH:** utilizing the Balkan conflicts as an entry point to reexamine and de-exceptionalize the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.
3. **STUDY GROUP:** group process focusing on students as active participants in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, allowing participants to explore their own individual and group identities.
4. **NEED-BLIND APPLICATION PROCESS:** ensuring that the best applicants participate in the program. Leadership skills, academic excellence, and commitment to a long term fellowship are essential requirements.
